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### This booklet is for families of children entering a new K-12 school in 2023-24.

Students who are currently enrolled in a charter school and plan to continue at that school in 2023-24 **do not need to reapply**.

### **Rochester families have public school options**

Charter schools offer families an opportunity to choose a K-12 school that best suits their child's needs from among Rochester's top performing schools. Rochester charter schools give city families education options—with 27 campus locations, charters offer quality academics, busing, athletics and after school programs to fit your schedule.

### What is GoodSchoolsRoc?

**GoodSchoolsRoc.org** is an application tool that makes it easy for families to learn about and apply to Rochester charter schools. The online application takes about 3-4 minutes to complete.

### What is a Charter School?

Charter schools are free public schools of choice, meaning that families choose them for their children. They operate with greater flexibility and more freedom to innovate, in return for greater accountability.

Charter schools are accountable for academic results and for upholding the promises made in their charters. They must demonstrate performance in the areas of academic achievement, financial management, and organizational stability.

Charters welcome all students, including those with special needs and English language learners.

More than 8,000 children attend Rochester charter schools and families have 27 area locations to choose from.

Students receive busing through their home district. In most cases, students who are eligible for district busing are transported by yellow bus. Some charter high schools use RTS services. Some charter schools provide busing even for students who live within 1.5 miles of the school location.

### What Makes Charter Schools Different?

Each charter school has its own mission and approach. Some focus on hands-on learning or specialized job training. Others have unique learning formats and classroom styles to help students work at their own pace.

This model gives educators the freedom to create different classroom experiences and allows students and families more flexibility in choosing the right education.

Charter schools are free public schools, but are not district schools.

Charter schools have their own individual school dress code policies, manu of which include uniforms. Manu schools provide discounts for uniforms and some provide free shirts to new students.

### **Preparation for Career and College**

Charter schools prepare students for the next stage of life. Whether that's college or a trade, students are provided with the tools and educational experiences that will help them after graduation.

Students who wish to pursue an education beyond high school are guided through the college application process. Most Rochester charter schools have a 90% or more college acceptance rate, but students make a variety of choices including entering trades or the general workforce, military careers and other training.

### **Starting Your Child in Kindergarten**

While students may apply to a charter school at any point during their academic career, many parents choose to start their child in kindergarten to give them a firm foundation and positive first school experience.

When students begin at a charter school in kindergarten, they are often accepted into their **first choice school**, avoiding waitlists that may occur at later grades.

Students who enter at a charter school in kindergarten take full advantage of the flexibility, personal attention and strong curriculum charter schools offer. Rochester kindergarten charter schools provide a safe school experience, built on relationships and trust and the flexibility to respond to today's changes and challenges.

### **Services and Learning Support**

Charter schools accept students who are English language learners, have IEPs or need extra learning support.

### Athletics

Rochester charter schools offer many sports, including baseball, basketball, bowling, cheerleading, cross-country, dance, football, golf, lacrosse, softball, soccer, track & field and volleyball.

### No Entrance Exams

Charter schools do not evaluate students for admission. Students are not given an advantage or disadvantage because of their academic standing, GPA or extracurricular activity participation. There are no tests or fees. Charter schools encourage applications from students who need extra help in school, have IEPs and are English language learners

### **Apply to Multiple Schools**

Students can apply to as many schools as they wish. Submitting applications to multiple schools does not hinder a student's chance for enrollment. If a student receives an offer from more than one school, it is up to the familu to choose which school to enroll.

If your K-12 student currently attends a charter school and does not wish to change schools, you do not need to complete an application. Your child will automatically be enrolled in the next grade at that school.

### **Charter Application at a Glance**

- 1. Visit GoodSchoolsRoc.org to learn about your public charter school options. Contact schools if you would like to schedule a visit.
- 2. Create an account on GoodSchoolsRoc.org using your email or phone number.
- 3. Complete the application, including name, address and current grade enrolled.

4. Select as many schools as you want to apply to. There is no limit, and you are not committing to any school at this point in e who the process.

5. Submit your online application using a phone, tablet or computer.

### **Lottery Deadline: April 1**

Families will be notified of acceptance for enrollment on or after April 11. Parents are encouraged to apply by the lottery deadline when schools have the most openings. Applications are accepted all year.

### **The Lottery**

If a charter school receives more applications than it has open seats available, the school conducts a lottery. Schools that do not receive more applications than openings are able to offer acceptances to all applicants without running a lottery. Chances of getting your first choice school are greatest if you apply by the lottery deadline when schools have the most openings.

The lottery is conducted through a computerized random drawing process. Students who don't receive an enrollment offer are automatically added to school waitlists. Students may receive offers from more than one school. Waitlisted students move up or are given a place as students enroll at their school of choice.

Applications are accepted year round. The sooner you apply after the lottery, the greater the chance of being accepted at the school of your choice.





### **Top 10 Reasons to Choose a Charter School**

- 1. As a parent, you are in control. Parents choose a school that best fits their child's needs. There are 27 charter school locations in the Rochester for parents to choose from.
- 2. Charter schools are free, public schools serving Kindergarten to 12th grade
- 3. More than 8,000 students are enrolled in Rochester charter schools—about 1/4 of Rochester's K-12 students
- A commitment to children. Rochester schools put students first and are committed to their education and wellbeing.
- 5. Smaller class sizes offer individualized learning support.
- 6. Safety and security are a top priority.

- 7. Charter schools encourage applications from students who have Special Needs, IEPs or are English Language Learners.
- 8. Charter schools enroll students of all levels. Charters help students who are struggling and need extra help in school and also students who are right on track or ahead of grade level.
- 9. You can apply to ALL Rochester charter schools with one simple online application. Just check the boxes where you'd like the application to be sent.
- 10. Some charter schools have special offerings: health sciences, science & technology, performing and visual arts, dual language programs, or a special focus on hands-on learning.


